

Mr. Muktadir Aziz is a Deputy Secretary to the Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh and is currently working as Private Secretary to Dr. Tawfiq-e-Elahi Chowdhury BB, Hon'ble Adviser (Minister) to the Hon'ble Prime Minister for Power, Energy and Mineral Resources Affairs.

Born in Noakhali, Muktadir had his early education in Majidee PTI and Noakhali Zilla School. Later he got Master of Public Administration from Dhaka University.

Muktadir started his career as Assistant Commissioner of 24th Batch of Bangladesh Civil Service (Administration) in 2005.
